Boat Ramp Hours

Closed on Saturdays, Sundays & Holidays from 10:00AM to 6:00PM

Boats and Jet Ski's need to remember NO WAKE ZONES

At the Public Beach Area and in All Coves

Swimmer's venturing out from beaches- you need to have a spotter with you!

THE WATER IS LOW AT THE LAKE

So, remember to use caution @ the Boat Ramp when launching your boat and watch for rocks around the lake. If possible, put buoy marker's around where rocks are to let boaters know.

Remember to be considerate of your neighbors and keep noise levels down.

SPEED LIMITS of 10mph should be observed on all camp roads for the safety of children, residents and your vehicle!
